


Current state of Play of the EIP on AHA After 2 invitations for commitment and Reference Site Awards

- 300 leading organisations
- 1000 regions & municipalities (from all 27 Member States)
- 30 million citizens & 2 million of patients involved
- Marketplace more than 30000 visits and more than 650 registered users
- 1 billion euro mobilised
- 32 innovative good practices (reference sites)





- Building on regional activities





Looking Ahead to H2020

- Health, Demographic Ageing a key priority under Europe 2020 – European Innovation Partnership and H2020
- Longer term R&D
 - VPH (in-silico medicine)
 - Personalised health and well-being
 - Active and assisted living (including also people with disabilities)
 - + Int: Cooperation, roadmapping, standards
- Applied R&D/Innovation
 - AAL Joint Programme (+ follow-up)
 - Pre-commercial procurement
- Take-up/Deployment support
 - Integrated care, Independent living, Inclusion
 - Public Procurement of Innovation



- Implementation of actions under Active and Healthy Ageing Partnership (join up) November 2012 onwards
- ICT call currently open: Challenge 5: ICT for Health, Ageing Well, Inclusion and Governance (deadline 15 January 2013)
- Horizon 2020 preparation under way
- AAL JP V2 discussion starts
- Major opportunities in ICT for Health and Ageing Well
